State Association Rewards Program

To encourage participation in Angus Impact throughout the nation, the NJAA will reward and honor any state association that has conducted more than 2 acts of service starting from August 2022 – June 2023. We will recognize any states who qualified at the 2023 National Junior Angus Show. Submissions from states will also be highlighted on the National Junior Angus Association social media.

How to Qualify:

To qualify for the rewards, the state association must return the 'Angus Impact Donation Form' to the Events and Junior Activities Department by **June 1, 2023**. *Please submit a form for each Act of Service completed.*

Examples of Acts of Service but certainly not limited to:

- Passing out cards at local nursing homes
- Making guilts for those in need
- Donations to local organizations in need of the 2023 Angus Impact theme
- Working at the local food bank
- Participating or organizing a charity race
